





## Guyana Trend in Total Program Expenditures by Funder Domestic Global Fund Gov't




## Distribution of HIV Funding by Program Area










## Guyana Distribution of Funder's Budget by Program Area, 2021




## **Distribution of HIV Commodity Funding**
